PLANNING AND ZONING APPOINTMENTS

After introductions, a motion was made by Councilman David Labrum to appoint Eric Larsen, Gwen Bellon and Chris Squire to serve 3-year terms on the Planning and Zoning Board. TRAFFIC STUDY LAGOON STREET AND 600 EAST

Chuck Richens from Horrocks Engineers presented the result of a traffic study done at Lagoon Street and 600 East to see the impact of increased traffic in front of the new Union High School. The report is that a four-way stop sign is warranted. Council discussed the best way to alert citizens who have been used to no stop signs. Councilman Aaron Weight asked that information be obtained on how much it would cost to upgrade the stop sign to have lighting to make it easier to notice.

APPLYING FOR FEDERAL GRANTS USING CONSULTANTS - FOLLOWUP

City Manager Ryan Snow reported on the results of calling on recommendations to make a better decision on contracting with a consultant. It would cost \$6,000 per month for a 90-day option to see how well it might work. After review and discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Aaron Weight to enter into a consulting contract to look into applying for federal grants for a 90-day period.. Motion seconded by Councilman Joe Burdick. Those voting Aye were Aaron Weight, Joe Burdick, Dustin White, David Labrum, and David Baird. Motion was carried unanimously.
