Minutes of the Roosevelt Arts, Parks and Recreation Committee

December 2, 2020

Roosevelt City Building

The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. by Wendy Nicholson, Chair

Roll Call: Amy Snow, Royce Porter, Jeramie Tubbs, Daniel Mauchley, Brent Fenn, Lee Nichole Marett, Wendy Nicholson

Minutes: Not enough committee members in attendance to approve the November minutes.

Public Comment: None

Business:

Rebranding: The city is setting up new branding guidelines. They would like to involve the public in the decisions. Possible things that are Roosevelt City identifiers: Teddy Roosevelt, Mountains. LeeNicole Marett asked how best to involve the public. It was suggested that a public contest be held for a new logo. It was suggested that school children be asked to participate and that a prize be offered. The new logo will be presented at UBIC 2021. UBTEch will create a welded version of the new logo.

Winterfest: We plan to send out a flyer with the December water bill.

Recreation: NCC will be doing a sledding day, no date set yet. No cross country skiing this year. The subcommittee might be getting some demo skis to try in late January of February. Purchasing 20-25 sets of skis would cost \$4000-\$5000. White Pine Skiing is willing to come out for a demo day. They would like to purchase a cross country skiing track setter. It would be pulled behind a snow mobile. The cost is \$600 and it could be purchased by mid-December. Considering putting together a winter Scavenger Hunt. It was decided that the Recreation subcommittee would purchase the track setter.

Parks: Pickleball tournament will be January 9 at 8 am at the Roosevelt Jr. High. They have some sponsors for the swag bags for each participant. Participants can sign up through the city's sports page. \$25 per hour to rent the jr. high. Brent will set up the registration.

Arts: Day of Dance, Photo Class on the 9th and 10th. Paint Night and Ceramics

Dates and activities need to be sent to Wendy no later than December 18. Wendy will email a reminder to the committee.

Reports from Subcommittees:

Arts: Christmas lights tour, "Bring on the Lights" has started. Community members submitted their own houses to be in the contest. The top three from a Facebook poll will get cash prizes. Fiddler on the Roof is December 12-19 at 7 pm. Online ticket purchases only.

Parks: None.

Recreation: The nature park is making good progress. There is good collaboration with the hospital. The pond idea might not work out. The location is north of the hospital and covers 14 acres. The Army Corp

of Engineers is working on a survey. It will be ADA accessible. Grant applications are being submitted. There will be good mature trees, and a walking path. Preston will send out a map. The Library is applying for a grant to get outdoor instruments to be installed on the grounds around the new library. Daniel Mauchley will be writing the grant.
