April 7, 2021

Call to order by Rowdy Cloward, Vice Chair

Reports from Subcommittees:

Arts: Britney Fenn said that Missoula Children's theater had contacted her about doing a production this year. It was decided that we would continue to do the production locally. Shannon Staker will speak with Mindy Palmer about running the program again this summer. It was discussed that it would be ok if Mindy wanted to charge a fee for the camp. The committee agreed that it would be ok. The committee will decide at the May meeting how much we can afford to give her out of our budget. All revenue will go back to the UHS drama department.

Mary Poppins at UHS will run May 7, 8, 10, 12, 14

Parks: Interest in pickleball is expanding. They are looking into building a court. The cost would be about \$250,000.

The grant that we expected to come from the state has been cancelled.

Recreation: There will be a 4th disc golf basket installed soon. The signs for the baskets have been ordered. There will be a sign design contest. All of the baskets now have sponsors. Some of the money will be used for the clinic. There will be a Disc Golf Clinic June 12, 9-11 a.m. at Constitution Park. Northeastern Counselling is buying 100 discs to hand out. Tricounty Health will provide breakfast. The subcommittee is applying for the Community Walks Grant.

The mountain bike trail will be cleaned up April 24th.

Preston recommended that we get on the agenda of the city council meeting periodically so that we can report on what are doing.

Rowdy Cloward will ask Mayor Bird about advertising to fill our vacant committee member spots.
